

Hands up survey for 5-11 year olds



Road casualties are the biggest killer of young people around the world.

This survey is designed for schools to use with groups of 5-11 year olds, to get their views on how safe they think the roads in their area are. To carry out the survey, simply ask for a show of hands for each question, marking the number of students that answer yes or no in the boxes, encouraging everyone to give honest answers.

We recommend you run this survey as part of a lesson, workshop or class discussion on road safety to engage students in this critical topic and get them thinking about road safety.

Discussion ideas for your lesson could include:

- What are roads like around school and home? Have they been different during COVID-19? Busier, quieter, more people walking etc? What safety features are there and how do they help protect people?
- What are the riskiest places for people on foot and bike? When is it hardest for drivers to see you?
- What can you do to be safer? What can drivers do to protect you? Why is walking and cycling good for you?
